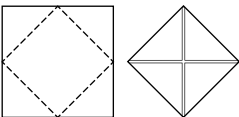


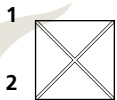


Peacock's Tail

1 – Fold the four corners in so that they meet in the center.



2 – Fold the four new outside corners in so that they meet in the center.



3 – Holding the folds firmly in place, turn the napkin over and again fold the outside corners in so that they also meet in the center.



4 – Press the center down with two fingers to hold the folds in place. With the other hand, lift each corner one at a time, picking up each loose point and sharply tugging at the center of the back side outward.

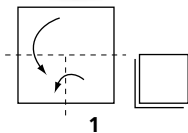


FANCY FOLDS

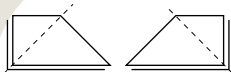


Peacock's Tail

1 – Fold a square napkin into quarters and place it in a diamond shape with the open corners to the left.



2 – Grasp the top layer of bottom left corner and gently pull it to the right edge to form a large triangle pointing upward. Turn the napkin over.



3 – Grasp the top layer of the bottom right corner and pull it gently and directly to the left to meet the bottom left corner until a large triangle results.

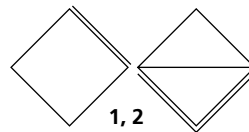


4 – Hold the folds together at the top point with one hand and fan out the four triangles with your other hand, with the points fanned evenly.



Ruffle

1 - Fold the napkin into quarters and place it in a diamond shape with the open corners pointing to the top.



2 – Fold the top layer down to meet the bottom point.

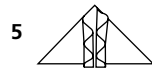
3 – Take the same top layer and pleat it four times, accordion style. A glass may be used to weigh the closed pleats down.



4 – Take the second layer of the top point and pleat it in the same manner, folding it at the same intervals as the first layer.

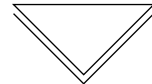


5 – While holding the center points of the pleats down, fold the right half of the napkin back and away from you.



The Dove

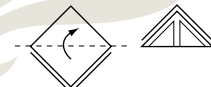
1 – Fold the napkin in half to form a triangle with the point facing down, toward you.



2 – Fold the right corner down to the bottom point. Repeat with the left corner.



3 – Turn the napkin over and bring the bottom point up to meet the top point to make a triangle.



4 – Lift the napkin up at the center to stand the napkin up on the two side edges.
